CANCELLATION POLICY: Money + Travel Coupon reimbursement

You have the option of transferring your deposit to another Yankee event, within 2 years and not pay the cancellation fee. Now to 90-days prior to the event: Refund, less a -\$100 administration fee, get a \$100 Travel Coupon. 30-days prior to the event: Refund, less a -25% cancellation fee of the total amount, get a Travel Coupon for the 25%. 29-days or less: No refund unless you have purchased the Optional Insurance.

31-Days OPTIONAL "TOUR EMERGENCY INTERRUPTION INSURANCE": Begins at the start of the 31-Day tour, for a FEE of \$3.50 per person, per day = \$217 (for 2 people,) you will receive a pro-rated refund of the days remaining on the rally, if a qualified emergency occurs causing you to have to leave the event before completion.
